Please return field trip permission slips by the end of April. Thank you!


Highlights this Week

This week we have a bunch of fun, new spring centers! As a math activity, the kids will get to make spring soup, counting different objects (carrots, peeps, bunnies, etc.) into a pot. They will use a recipe to see how much of each object to add to their soup! Also, we have a flower measuring activity with snap cubes. The kids can place the snap cubes in a row and then count how many cubes long is each flower.

At table time, we will use letter beads to spell a variety of spring words. We will also use simple CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words such as C-A-T or N-A-P. The kids are really starting to show that they hear some of the separate sounds in a word.

Caterpillars!

We have caterpillars in preschool! We are excitedly watching them eat and grow. We are hoping that by the end of the week, we start to see them form their chrysalids and then transform into butterflies.



Toys in Preschool
