


# Performance Indicator Report Student Connectedness Log – Avoca West

#### **Summary and Analysis**

- 1. Avoca West offered 25 extra-curricular opportunities for students to be involved in a program outside of the required school day activities.

- 2. 327 of 402 1st through 5<sup>th</sup> grade Avoca West students (81%) participate in at least one activity beyond the typical academic offerings.
- 3. The percentage of students participating in an extra-curricular activity at 1st grade continues to rise, which bodes well for future participation, too.
- 4. The total percentage of 1st through 5th graders participating in at least one activity continues to hold steady at a very respectful 81%.
- 5. 57% of 1st-5th grade students participated in at least two activities. This is a steep increase over previous years.





## 2017-2018 Performance Indicator Report Student Connectedness Log – Marie Murphy

### Summary and Analysis

- 1. In 2017-2018 Marie Murphy School offered 24 different opportunities for students to "get connected" with their school. Those opportunities breakdown in the following manner:

- 2. 79% of middle school students participated in at least one extra-curricular activity.
  - a. In total, of 263 students at Marie Murphy School, 209 took advantage of extracurricular opportunities 810 times!
- 3. 6<sup>th</sup> grade participation (74%), though not as high as the previous cohort of 6th graders, is similar to that cohort from their 5th grade year (73%).
- 4. While 6th and 7th grade participation is down from the previous group of 6th and 7th grade students, 8th grade has held steady in the mid 80s for the last three years.
- 5. While overall the total percent of participants is down this year, impressively, 20% of MM students participated in 5 or more extra-curricular activities!
